Oireachtas Hotels Open 6/3

Hard to believe we're talking about Oireachtas already. **For those of you who qualify to compete at Oireachtas as a solo dancer and for those on Worlds/Nationals teams who plan to dance on teams at Oireachtas**, the hotel blocks open for booking on Monday, 6/3 at 12 noon EST. Details attached. Team dancers who are not qualified for solo competitions are invited to dance their Traditional Set.

Booking Note: All reservation requests will require a credit card guarantee, a non-refundable one-night's room and tax deposit at time of reservation.

For planning your stay, the days only schedule follows:

- Friday: U14 & over solos
- Saturday: teams & trad sets
- Sunday: U8-U13 solos

Teams will need to be in Louisville and ready to rehearse on Friday by 4 pm.

Summer Feiseanna Planning - Important Info

In addition to the feiseanna this weekend, other local or nearby feis opportunities include:

- **Northern Mid-America Championship Feis / 10,000 Lakes Feis - June 15 & 16 - quickfeis.com**
 - **Register on QuickFeis** - If you haven't registered with QuickFeis before, you'll have to create family and dancer profiles. Please note, if you've previously been on a team or competed at Oireachtas, you will have an account already since the MidAmerica Region Oireachtas uses QuickFeis..
 - Nationals Ceili Teams are **required** to perform in teams at the 10,000 Lakes Feis on **Sunday ONLY**. Solo competition at the June Feiseanna is at your own discretion.
 - These feiseanna are hosted by the Mulhern school.
 - Cormac and Natalie will only be there for First Feis and teams. It is the same weekend as an annual CIM event at the Celtic Junction. Other teachers will be there to help!
 - Please note, Saturday's feis includes a "Second Chance." Dancers may enroll in the Second Chance to dance again that afternoon. It's basically a double feis in one day! See attached for more information.
