- You may send in multiple videos - we may not use them all - but will include a video of everyone who sends one or more in. Please email only one video at a time.

Directions:

- All videos need to use music from Cormac's Feistunes recordings. (A link will be provided if you need to download a tune.)
- Videos should be shot in **landscape** orientation, not portrait orientation.
- Videos can be screen recordings of Zoom collaborations
- Wear your solo costume, your LOVE O'Shea shirt or any other costume - even your workout clothes.



Ideas/Examples to get you started!

- Make a group video using Zoom

- Make a TikTok style video like these: <https://www.tiktok.com/tag/irishdance?lang=en> - Make sure you use Feistunes music.
- Do a step of your hard or soft shoe from class or competitions
- Choreograph your own steps
- Siblings dance together "feis style"

Video Tips

- Find a creative place to dance
- Make sure it is light enough
- Avoid light directly BEHIND what you are filming
- Keep the camera stationary or move it very little or very slowly.
- Avoid fast or shaky camera movements
