Costume Days for Upcoming Feiseanna and Spring Recitals

We are holding two costume days before the OID and Leap Into Spring Feiseanna for dancers who will be using their class costumes to compete in the upcoming Feiseanna or who do not yet have a class costume or one that fits. Costume fittings will be held on April 20 and April 22 from 4:30 pm to 6:30 pm by sign-up only. Please use this form to sign-up so we know when you plan to come. Reminder that dancers using the stretch velvet "performance" dresses in competition will need to wear the black collar piece that goes with it. Necklines in competition attire cannot show collarbones. If you plan to come before class, please note that depending on the number of dancers being fit for costumes, your dancer may be late for class. Please allow enough time so your dancer is not late for class.
