### Myofascial Release Therapist at CJAC on Wednesdays

Derrick Lundberg, Natalie's massage therapist and friend, is a licensed massage therapist trained in Myofascial Release, Osteopathic Manual Therapies and Oriental Medicine.

#### **Decade of Dance Awards**

The annual Decade of Dance awards will be awarded by Irish Arts Minnesota (formerly IMDA) on March 19, 2023 at Landmark Center during the Day of Dance. A dancer who would like to receive the

Decade of Dance Award in March 2023 must submit an application to be reviewed and approved by IAM's Decade of Dance Award Committee.

The dancer must meet all of the following criteria:

- Participated in Irish Dance for 10 full years\*. Dancers applying for the award to be presented in March 2023 must have started studying Irish dance in the Fall of 2012 or before.
- Participated for a minimum of one (1) full year\* must be with a Twin Cities Irish dance school or performance group.
- Performed at least once at IAM/IMDA's St. Patrick's Day Irish Celebration or IAM/IMDA's Day of Irish Dance.
- If injured, attended classes during their recovery.
- Be recommended by an Irish Dance Instructor or Director from the Twin Cities.

\* A full year begins in the Fall and ends in the Spring (Summers are optional).

The application is now on IAM's NEW website: <u>IrishArtsMN.org</u>. Applications are due on Dec. 1, 2022. IAM will review the applications and confirm by Feb. 15, 2023.
